ISS Ltd is currently appointed as Catering Contractor under this contract.

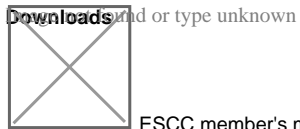
Menus are run on a three-week cycle and change twice during the academic year to allow for seasonal changes and ensure variety. The menus are developed to provide healthy and balanced choices that are appealing to children while being compliant with the School Food Standards.

In 2015 the Department for Education introduced the School Food Standards, as part of the School Food Plan.
