It is now a legal requirement to ensure websites and online documents are accessible.

Web content

Making accessible content is not hard and can help all users, not just those with disabilities.

Online documents

As the creator of online documents it will be the services responsibility to make sure they are accessible.

More time and effort is required in making accessible documents, so only add documents to the website where it's really important that schools have access to it (or there's a legal requirement for it) and there's no other way to present the information.

If you really have to add the document, then it needs to be made accessible. Find out how to do this on [how to make documents accessible](#) – read the guidance document first, then watch the short how-to videos.

- that are no longer required
- created after 23 September 2018 that should be made accessible.
