



## Join the school safe scheme

24 Jan 2025

Schools should report any potentially dangerous incident involving a pupil when it occurs on the way to or from school, or during the school day, via the [Ealing school safe scheme](#).

### Reporting to the police

Schools are encouraged to contact the police in case of serious incidents. In particular if the incident involves:

- Pupils being approached or followed by strangers
- Strangers taking photographs of pupils
- Unfamiliar persons present on school grounds
- Possible abduction attempts.

A crime report is not necessary for all incidents. If you are unsure whether to inform the police you can dial 101 or report it online at [www.met.police.uk](http://www.met.police.uk) and an assessment will be made.
