Successful transition happens where:

- · Transition is made a priority
- · Children are familiar with the people, places and routines
- · Parents are involved, consulted and supported
- · Routines and approaches to learning and teaching are relaxed and flexible
- · Friendships are acknowledged
- · There is a degree of predictability
- An effective key person system is in place
- Children have opportunity to take control of what is happening to them within a safe yet challenging place.
