From April 2024 working parents will be able to claim **15 hours a week** of funding towards their childcare costs (eligibility criteria, terms and conditions apply).

Childcare funding is changing

From **April 2024**, eligible working parents of two-yearolds will be able to access 15 hours of funded childcare per week, 38 weeks of the year.

From **September 2024**, 15 hours childcare support will also be offered to eligible working parents of children from the ages of nine months to three years.

From **September 2025**, eligible working parents of children between the ages of nine months and four years will be entitled to 30 hours of childcare a week.

This is **in addition** to the childcare funding schemes already available for two, three and four-year-olds.
