Co-production, the SEND strategy and families

Ealing local Authority have asked partners (NHS, schools and voluntary sector services), children, young people and parent and carers what they need to improve, and want to let you know they are committed to improving it as quickly as possible. In partnership they want to coproduce a single strategy and joined up system to improve outcomes for children and young people with SEND and their families.

Ealing council will be accountable for doing what they say they will and for letting people know how well they are doing.
