- Collaborate with secondary school colleagues to review Science curriculum knowledge linking to scientific enquiry to prepare students to be successful at KS3

- Present updates on the collaboration and share findings with primary schools in your cluster
- Meet secondary school colleagues four half days or two full days during the academic year in person or online as necessary
- Record outcomes of visits and share with Teach West London
- Complete a short evaluation report at the end of the summer term using an agreed framework (WWW, evidence of impact, EBI, priorities for next year)
- Ensure all project documentation and materials are accessible to the network via the Teach West London Google drive
