Outreach training, intervention, and provision for SEMH needs support packages



Packages	Provision
Inform <i>Training</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Centralised training ▪ School INSET
Support <i>Developing in school provision</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Specialist teacher to develop, in partnership with the school, an individual provision plan for target child ▪ Review fortnightly over 6 weeks with school and parents
Engage <i>Specialist teaching and assessment</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 6-week specialist teacher intervention (individual or small group) ▪ Assessment report with recommendations for school-based support and other agency support
Engage Plus	Following or alongside the Engage intervention <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Audit of school's SEMH provision (targeted at referral concerns)
Invest <i>Specialist mental health support</i>	Following recommendation from Support or Engage intervention <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 8-week intervention by clinical psychologist with family and child ▪ Assessment report with recommendations for support
Invest Plus	Following on from the Invest intervention <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Ongoing clinical psychologist intervention, purchased in 12-week blocks

Training

Provision: Centralised training

Behaviour Management

- Behaviour Management for ECTs (NQTs)
- Developing classroom Behaviour Management
- Behaviour Management for support staff

Understanding and supporting SEMH Needs:

- Attachment difficulties
- Children who have experienced Trauma
- ADHD and conduct disorders
- De-escalating challenging behaviour

School INSET The central training offer can also be delivered as school INSET, plus:

- Developing whole school systems and practice for positive behaviour

Costs: From £275 (1hr)

Support

Developing in school provision

Provision: For children referred to the 'support' package

1. A specialist teacher will visit school to review the child's SEN information with the SENCO, observe child in class and meet class teacher
2. Develop a 'Plan, Do, Review' cycle, with specific targets and interventions that the school will implement
3. Attend an initial meeting with the SENCO, parents/carers and, as appropriate, child
4. Review with the school, parents/carers, and child fortnightly over a 6-week period

Timescale: 8-week intervention

Cost: £840

Engage

Specialist teaching and assessment

Provision: For children referred to the 'engage' package

1. A specialist teacher will visit school to review the child's SEN information with the SENCO, observe child in class and meet class teacher
2. Specialist teacher to develop and deliver a 6-week intervention with the referred child, individually or as part of a small group
3. Attend an initial meeting with SENCO, parents/carers, and child at the start of the intervention
4. Attend a review meeting with SENCO, parents/carers, and child at the end of the intervention

Provide an assessment report with recommendations for further school-based support and other agency support

Timescale: 8-week intervention

Cost: £2,050

Engage Plus

Audit of school's behavioural and SEMH systems in relation to a referred child

Provision:

1. A senior leader will observe whole school systems and how they are supporting the referred child
2. Provide a written report to school detailing the observed good practice and further recommendations

Timescale: 1 week process

Cost: £550

Invest

Specialist mental health intervention

Provision: Following recommendation from the support or engage intervention, provided by

- the clinical psychologist will:
 - Meet with the SENCO, class teacher and other significant school-based staff
 - Meet with the child for 4 sessions
 - Meet with the parent/carers for 2 sessions
- Call a joint consultation meeting with school staff and parents to share the outcome of their intervention and recommendations for future support
- Provide a written record of the above
- Share all records and information with relevant medical professionals, including the child's GP and other CAMHS professionals

Timescale: 8-week intervention

Cost: £2,520

Invest Plus

Ongoing specialist mental health intervention

Provision: Following on from the Invest intervention, if it is recommended, ongoing clinical psychologist intervention may be purchased in 12-week blocks

Timescale: 12-week intervention

Cost: £2,730

General Support

Specialist Teacher

Provision: A range of support activities provided by the specialist teacher, as negotiated with the school

Timescale: ½ or 1 day

Cost:

- ½ day: £275
- 1 day: £500

Credit System

Schools start the year with an amount of 'credit' that they can use, depending on their pupil numbers.

Any school requiring additional service above their credit can buy it in.

For example, this would be an appropriate use, for a child with SEMH needs, of the £6,000 SEN support fund that schools are notionally delegated

Credit amounts based on school size:

Number on roll (rec – Yr. 6)	Credit
Academy/Free	£0
195+	£1,500
380+	£3,000
570+	£4,500
760+	£6,000

Separately to the above, the commissioning of clinical psychology support will also be available.

This will be a commissioned service and is not part of the outreach offer. Schools will **not** be able to use their 'credit' to part purchase this option.

Commissioned services: Clinical psychology in schools

Timescale: 7 hrs a week (delivered on 1 day) of Clinical Psychology support over 33 weeks

Cost: £14,750

This is a subsidised cost, thanks to a John Lyons grant

- Individual assessment and professional report writing
- Evidence based therapeutic work children, parents, and families
- Parenting groups
- Consultation to staff
- Supervision/support to staff
- Training
