



Secondary Outreach Lead to support scientific enquiry in primary schools

Job Description

- Support primary schools to review Science curriculum knowledge linking to scientific enquiry to prepare students to be successful at KS3
- Work with primary school colleagues to identify strategies to further support scientific enquiry
- Work with primary school colleagues to embed these strategies and monitor progress throughout the year
- Run CPD sessions for primary school colleagues in one or more of the following areas:
 - Subject knowledge workshops (Biology/Chemistry/Physics)
 - Setting success criteria for practical work
 - o Workshop on how to deliver Biology/Chemistry/Physics practical lessons
 - o Running scientific enquiry observations at secondary school
- Visit the partner primary school once per half term and provide online support where necessary
- Record outcomes of primary school visits and share with Teach West London
- Inform Teach West London of issues identified during school visits
- Complete a short evaluation report at the end of the summer term using an agreed framework (WWW, evidence of impact, EBI, priorities for next year)
- Ensure all project documentation and materials are accessible to the network via the Teach West London Google drive
